





DEADLINE for AWARD SUBMISSIONS JANUARY 14, 2024

Polka artists interested in possible music awards national (Slovenian, Czech, German, Dutchmen, recognition now have an easy electronic method to get on the ballot! Beginning this year, all working polka artists seeking IPA awards for the current year must go online to www.ipapolkas.com/ application-musicawards to submit their information. All those who register are eligible for the IPA's Favorite Band and Favorite Vocalist award categories. Recording artists have a special section to upload their musical tracks and graphics to be considered for their additional awards. In all, deserving polka artists are recognized with music awards that include Favorite Album, Favorite Song, Favorite Band, Favorite Male Vocalist, and Favorite Female Vocalist for Polish and Inter-


etc.) polka styles. An academy of 195 electors from across the country determines the award winners by casting their votes on annual ballots. The lists of polka artists on these ballots will be generated by the submissions received through the new electronic process. So, you've got to submit every year to win! Complete instructions are available on the website. The deadline to submit for consideration in the next voting cycle is January 14, 2024. Eligible recordings must have been released between January 1 and December 31, Questions may be directed MusicAwards@ipapolkas.com.











Deadline for IPA Hall of Fame Submissions is December 31st

Each year, the International Polka Association recognizes select polka professionals, living and deceased, with induction into the IPA Polka Hall of Fame. The Board of Trustees reviews the qualifications of Hall of Fame nominees to determine if they meet the criteria for placement on the ballot. An academy of 195 electors from across the country uses these ballots to determine those to be inducted in the annual voting cycle. **Nominations must be submitted by December 31st.** Visit www.ipapolkas.com for the complete list of details.

Deadline for Joe Jozwiak Special Achievement Award Submission is December 31st

Many years ago, the late Joseph Jozwiak, a director of the IPA, made a suggestion that an award be bestowed upon an individual or group of individuals who have made a significant contribution or endeavor to enhance the promotion of polka music. After much discussion, the IPA voted to honor those worthy individuals with the establishment of the Special Achievement Award. To pay tribute to Joe Jozwiak, following his passing, this award was renamed the Joe Jozwiak Special Achievement Award.

Members of the IPA are invited to send in their nominations to recognize polka personalities who might not otherwise be acknowledged for their dauntless contributions. Nominees can include DJs, polka writers, promoters, ballroom operators, etc. **Bands and musicians are excluded.**

To submit a nomination, complete the form below, include a short biography of the nominees' accomplishments that qualify him or her for this award. Nominations MUST be received NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 31st. The IPA Board of Directors and Officers will then determine a winner. Visit www.ipapolkas.com for the complete list of details.





Das Beste Oktoberfest in La Crosse, WI

Voted one of the top Octoberfest in the Midwest, I was able to attend the 63rd Annual Das Beste Oktoberfest in La Crosse Wisconsin the weekend of September 28 to 30, 2023. Johnny and I headed to Wisconsin on Friday afternoon and made it in time to hear IPA Hall of Fame Inductee, Gary Brueggen and his Ridgeland Dutchman Band perform, as always, the band sounded fantastic and his son Mason on drum, has grown up so fast and is extremely talented. Johnny and I even had a chance to catch up with Jim Busta, who was also in attendance. On Saturday, the Bratwurst Brothers performed on the main stage, the same time that Brian Brueggen and the Mississippi Valley Dutchman were performing. I was able to sneak over to hear them perform to a full tent of Octoberfest attendees. The Bratwurst Brothers were on fire, playing all of the crowd's favorites as they sang and danced the afternoon away. Brian and the Band also sounded amazing and had their tent dancing to every tune! There were three stages of music all weekend long. A little history of this festival was published on the Tasting Table website.

The Das Beste Oktoberfest in La Crosse, Wisconsin is undoubtedly the best in the state and maybe even the best in the Midwest. The first

Oktoberfest in La Crosse was held back in 1961. Originally organized out of necessity for a community-wide event in the city, considering the German-American population, an Oktoberfest was the obvious choice.

The original objectives of the first La Crosse Oktoberfest were to promote local pride in La Crosse, obtain national publicity, promote tourism, involve a large number of people, and break even financially (it's run by a non-profit organization). What started as a small festival to bring the local community together has blossomed into a massive celebration that draws visitors from all over. It continues to sustain and thrive as the longest-running annual Oktoberfest in the region.

Events included in Das Beste Oktoberfest include a craft beer night, tapping of the golden keg, and a fireworks celebration on Saturday night. Hundreds of beers from all over the country and world are available on tap, as well as locally-made brats and other German staples. As dozens of musical acts perform one after the other all three days, the fun never stops. This Oktoberfest is a must-visit for anyone living in the region, and it may just warrant a visit from beyond.

Angela's Toffee Dip submitted by Angela Biskup

1 package cream cheese (regular or light)

1/4 cup brown sugar

caramel sauce

2 Skor bars (Heath bars)

Beat cream cheese with brown sugar until smooth.

Layer in low serving dish.

Spread layer of caramel sauce.

Crush Skor bars and sprinkle on top.

Chill if desired.

Serve with sliced apples.

(version two)

3/4 cup packed brown sugar

1/2 cup powdered (icing) sugar

1 tsp vanilla

1 pkg cream cheese, softened (regular or light)

3/4 cup toffee bits (skor bits)

Combine first 4 ingredients in a bowl mixing in mixer at medium speed until smooth.

Add toffee bits, mix well.

Cover and chill.

Serve with sliced apples.

Prepare sliced apples:

1 cup pineapple juice

3-4 Red delicious apples, cored, cut into wedges

3-4 granny smith apples, cored, cut into wedges

Combine juice and apples in bowl, toss well. (Pineapple juice stops apples from turning brown)

Drain apples.

Place apples in airtight container, seal, chill.

Serve dip with apples.

Make up to 12 hours ahead.







General update/thank you's from Jim Busta

Greetings:

Celebration of 45 Years of the Jim Busta Band. This was a great celebration held at the La Crosse Oktoberfest Grounds on Wednesday, August 16th. It was attended by an estimated crowd of 550-600 people. Thanks to the La Crosse Oktoberfest people, Chad Busta and Mollie Busta for putting this together on a 10-day notice of time. We had people from 10 different states in attendance (including from the states of California and New York). Many musicians were present who have played in the band over the years....and many other musicians, as well. Even though we requested no gifts, some gifts were given anyway - so thank you. A cash bar was also available provided by the La Crosse Oktoberfest. A complimentary light meal and water/soft drinks were provided, and donations were accepted for these. After expenses, we (Mary Lou and I) were able to provide \$1,500 in donations of \$500 each to the following charitable organizations: The La Crosse Salvation Army, St Jude's Children's Research Hospital, and Shriners Hospitals for Children.

Other: My primary" nurse/doctor" at our house, my wife - Mary Lou, had hip surgery on September 18th. She is doing very well and came home the day after surgery.
