### FL Musician Spotlight:

In this issue I would like to feature Mr. Bobby Sendra. Bobby is originally from Chicago, ILL. and was born into a musical family. His father played drums for the Chuck Stevens Orchestra and was a big influence on his developing years. When Bobby was 9, his dad passed away and he picked up his dad's drum set and started playing, setting into motion the trajectory of his storied music career.

When Bobby was 14 his stepfather, Joe Novak, took him to Roy Knapp Studios in downtown Chicago for professional lessons. For the next 9 years he learned to read musical charts and developed his own style and techniques, just like his drummer idol Buddy Rich. Bobby and his brother Rich, who was learning the accordion at the time, became a duo. They played for various local events like house parties, weddings, picnics and many other events. Bobby was also at this time, playing in his high band, for which he received the John Phillips Souza award for I would personally like to send Bobby a very special excellent musicianship.

Bobby and Rich met up with musicians Jerry Chocholek and Peter Drungle and they both joined the band. The band diversified their sounds and ventured into the rock & roll genre, playing more gigs. Along the way they entered a Chicago-area local band contest. When entering the contest, the promoter asked them for the band's name. Bobby and the guys didn't have a band name, so the promoter suggested they call themselves "The Versatones" and that is how the name was born. The Ver- Polish American Pulaski Club of Daytona Beach band as local legends. The following year, The Versatones entered another band contest sponsored by Downbeat Magazine and they finished in the top 3.

Gradually, the young Versatones shifted back to polka music and Bobby, Rich and Jerry became a

trio. Chet Kowalkowski joined the band shortly after on trumpet. They began doing radio broadcast on Chet Schaeffer & Chet Gulinski shows, and Club 505. In 1963 Eddie Blazonczyk joined the band playing bass and singing. The band became a power house and took off playing in many states. In

1964, the band became nationally known thru out the polka hot spots, changing their name to Eddie Blazonczyk's Versatones. Bobby was working a fulltime job but still managing to travel to PA, NY, Ohio, WI, Mich., MD, NJ, Del., and Canada.

In 1967 the band was still going strong, continuing to play gigs across the US. Bobby was already married, had a family, and was working for Standard Oil Co. The traveling became too much for him and he had to end his career with Eddie, Rich, Jerry and Chet. He played 10 years with The Versatones, recorded 6 albums, along with the #1 "Twinkletoes". Bobby played locally with Musicalaires, The Dynamics, Naturals and other local bands for many years after The Versatones.

In 2010 Bobby retired. Him and his wife Judy move to sunny Inverness, Florida. Bobby, still itching to play polka music, hooks up with The Florida New Generation Band. Today, Bobby is still active in the local polka scene, playing with some of the Northern Polka bands that come to Florida during snowbird season.

"Thank You" for keeping polka beat alive in the state, and I wish him the very best of luck in the future. Bobby has created a unique style of playing polka music along with his whistle, for special effects. You can catch Bobby filling in with Polka Bands throughout the year and even teaching me a few drum lessons, from time to time.




