Announcing the Winner of the 4th Annual IPA Young Songwriter's Competition

Congratulations to Andrew Ratajczak for his 1st Place-winning song, "Good People".

The competition is in its fourth year and was suggested by Chicago IPA Director Stephen Kaminski. It is intended to cultivate new music in the polka genre and inspire young composers.

Every year, a panel of noted experts, in different styles of polka music, are selected as judges. The judges remain anonymous and the composers names are not given to the judges. Songs are judged with the same rubric on a points-based rating system. The judges rate each song according to memorability, desire to listen again, lyrics (or if an instrumental, comparison to other known instrumental hits), originality, ability to keep the listener engaged, lead sheet accuracy, melodic structure, use of chords, and use of key changes. Each judge can then award bonus points for songs they feel are deserving of extra points, which are completely at each judge's discretion.

All points are gathered from the individual judges and tallied. The song with the most points becomes our 1st Place Winner, the second highest tally becomes our 2nd Place Winner, and so on. The 1st Place Winner is then not eligible to submit a song in the following year's competition.

This year's 2nd Place Winner was Matthew Adamski for his song "Polka Town".

The IPA invites all eligible composers out there to work on their best polka and plan on submitting it next year. Each composer is allowed one song, unless a co-write with another composer. You too could win one thousand dollars, a beautiful plaque, and most importantly, bragging rights!

So sharpen your pencils, tune your instruments, and submit your masterpiece in the 5th Annual IPA Young Songwriter's Competition. We hope to see you in 2024!

Recipes from ... JPA Members

VAMPIRE KISS JELLO SHOTS



Ingredients

- •1 Box Jell-O cherry flavour, 3.5 Oz.
- •1 Cup water boiling
- •1/2 Cup whiskey Fireball cinnamon whiskey
- •1/2 Cup water cold
- •food dye gel in black
- 1. Combine the Jell-O and hot water in a medium mixing bowl and stir until Jell-O has been fully dissolved.
- 2. Add the Fireball and cold water. Stir well.
- 3. Pour half of the Jell-O mixture into a pourable measuring cup or another bowl.
- 4. To one of the bowls/containers add the black food dye and stir well.
- 5. Line a cookie sheet with 10 shot cups.
- 6. Fill the cups about half full of the red Jell-O and chill for about an hour until set.
- 7. Fill the cup the rest of the way with the black Jell-O mixture and chill for another hour or until set.
- 8. Cover cups with lids and serve.





Pumpkin Martini

- 2 ounces* vodka
- ½ ounce heavy cream (or coconut milk, for vegan)
- ½ ounce (to 1 ounce**) pure maple syrup
- 2 tablespoons canned pumpkin puree
- 1/4 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice
- 1/4 teaspoon vanilla extract
- Graham crackers, for the rim
- 1. **Prepare the rim:** Crush a graham cracker with your fingers, and place it on a plate. On another plate, add a small pool of maple syrup. Run the rim of a martini glass in the maple syrup first, rotating the glass so the rim is evenly coated. Then roll the rim in the crushed graham crackers until evenly coated.
- 2. **Shake the drink:** Place all ingredients in a cocktail shaker. Add a handful of ice and shake until cold. Strain the drink into the prepared martini glass.

JPA 2023 Polka Music Awards Notice

Polka Recording Companies and Artists Must Submit Nominations by January 14, 2024

Each year, the International Polka Association recognizes deserving polka artists with music awards that include *Favorite Album*, *Favorite Song*, *Favorite Band*, *Favorite Male Vocalist*, and *Favorite Female Vocalist* for Polish and International (Slovenian, Czech, German, Dutchmen, etc.) polka styles. An academy of 195 electors from across the country determines the award winners by casting their votes on ballots generated by submissions from those artists.

In order to be listed on the ballot, independent artists, bandleaders, executive producers, or record label representatives must complete the electronic *IPA Polka Music Awards Application*. Recording artists must submit the musical tracks of the recording and related artwork with liner notes as instructed in the form. Recordings must be released between January 1st and December 31st of a given year and the submission received by the following January 14th to be considered in the next voting cycle. 
