Annual IPA Polka Hall of Fame and Music Awards Update

New Award: Favorite International Polka Album

The International Polka Association is preparing to conduct the balloting for the annual Polka Music Awards that will determine the Favorite Polish Polka Album, Favorite International Polka Album, Favorite Song, Favorite Male Vocalist, Favorite Female Vocalist, and Favorite Band for 2015. Note that the Favorite International Polka Album is a new award that recognizes a deserving album from the non-Polish styles such as Slovenian, Czech, German, Dutchmen, etc.

To ensure all qualified recordings and artists are included on the ballot, recording companies and polka artists must download, complete, and submit the IPA Polka Music Awards Affidavit found on the IPA web site at www.ipapolkas.com. The document is located under the "Hall of Fame/Awards" tab. A physical recording in compact disc (CD) format must accompany the affidavit and be mailed to: IPA Polka Music Awards, P.O. Box 91, Dover, DE 19903, postmarked by January 14, 2016. The completed affidavit may also be scanned and emailed to: ipahalloffame@gmail.com, but the CD must still be submitted even if the recording was digitally released. Please note that only recordings released between January 1 and December 31, 2015 are eligible for the Favorite Polish Polka Album, Favorite International Polka Album, and Favorite Song awards. Eligible recording companies and artists may nominate one song for Favorite Song award consideration from each released recording. Recordings released in previous years are not eligible, even if re-released as part of a new compilation album.

Prompt action is vital to ensure deserving polka recordings and artists are properly recognized for the good of the entire polka industry. Any questions concerning this process should be directed to Fred Bulinski at <u>ipahalloffame@gmail.com</u> or (443) 956-3087.

IPA Appoints New Trustee

Since the establishment of the IPA Polka Music Hall of Fame and annual Music Awards presentations back in 1968, 11 trustees have governed the processes that select Hall of Fame (HOF) inductees and recognize polka artists with awards. Each trustee is appointed by the IPA President, with the concurrence of the Executive Board, and oversees 14 other electors chosen to represent a given geographic area of the United States and Canada. These 165 electors participate in the annual voting that elects HOF inductees and music award winners.

To better serve a large portion of the U.S. and its diversity of polka styles, the Executive Board recently approved the recommendation of the Polka Music Hall of Fame and Music Awards Committee to establish a new trustee position to represent Texas, Oklahoma, and New Mexico. This additional position brings the number of trustees up to 12, which will in turn increase the number of national electors to 180. To fill the new trustee position, the Executive Board chose Danny Zapletal, one of several qualified candidates identified by the committee. Danny "Z" is an Ennis, Texas native who has been involved with the Ennis National Polka Festival for many years. He was appointed Vice-President in 1992, President in 1993, and has served as the festival's Executive Director since 2000. He is the host of two polka shows broadcast in both Texas and Wisconsin. As a trumpet player, Danny joined the *Texas Dutchmen* back in 1980 and now leads and performs with the *Czech and Then Some* band. He also owns a recording studio where most of the polka bands from northern Texas record. Danny is proud and knowledgeable of his Czech heritage but is also familiar with all polka styles. The IPA welcomes Danny to its academy of electors and looks forward to leveraging his knowledge in serving the polka industry at large.

IPA Mourns the Passing of Marge Machay

On October 24, 2015, Margaret M. Machay, nee Jagielski, the longtime owner and operator of Polonia Banquets, passed away. She was the beloved wife of the late Charles Machay, loving mother of Michael (Norma), Sandra (John) Mikrut, Mark, Susanne and Brian (Mary), proud grandmother of ten grandchildren, and dearest friend of Dave Ulczycki. She is also survived by sisters, brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law, nieces, and nephews.

In 1964, Marge and her late husband Chuck established the Polonia Ballroom & Grove that went on to become a Chicago landmark. To accommodate their growing business in the 1980's, they initiated a major facility renovation and changed its name to the present Polonia Banquets. The Machays have always unselfishly leveraged their establishment to promote polka music in addition to their catering services. For fifty years they hosted events with top polka entertainment that drew crowds from all over the United States and Canada. They showcased weekend-long picnics, festivals, and dances to support the International Polka Association and hosted the nationally known Bel-Aire Polka Days, produced by Eddie Blazonczyk. The family business at 4604 S. Archer Ave. in Chicago continues to be a hub for polka entertainment and events for the community. The Machay family has also expanded their business with their famous Polonia Catering to a second location in suburban Chicago. Thanks to Marge's example, Polonia Banquets continues to operate today with the same high



standards of excellence. After a half of century, it's quite possible that Polonia Banquets is the longest-running polka establishment under the same management in the USA.

In addition to managing her business, Marge found time to serve on the IPA Executive Board as Treasurer and Director from Illinois for many years. She even served as IPA Festival & Convention Ad Book Chairperson for several years. Back when the IPA building was sold, Marge came forward and provided space at Polonia Banquets to house and display the precious polka artifacts that make up today's IPA Polka Hall of Fame Museum. What a lasting tribute to a great businesswoman and beloved polka promoter.

IPA Director T. Ron Jasinski-Herbert Passes



IPA Director T. Ron Jasinski-Herbert passed away on August 17, 2015. T. Ron earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from DePaul University, and LLB and JD degrees also from DePaul University and remained an active alumnus.

T. Ron celebrated life and embraced every effort to improve his community. Among his many accomplishments: T. Ron was President of Ameripol, Corporation, Inc.; President of Polonia Media Network; Publisher and Editor-in-Chief of "Polonia Today"; President of the Polish Arts Club of Chicago; past President and current Advocate of the Chicago Society PNA; founding President and current member of the Board of the Chicago Society Foundation; Director of the International Polka Association; Director of the Polish American Congress; former Director of Public Relations of the Polish National Alliance; founder, along with his mother Lee Herbert, of the Heritage Club of Polish Americans; Past President of the Advocates Society; past Director of the Polish National Alliance; past Director of the Polish American Congress, Illinois Division, practiced law in his office on Milwaukee Avenue; founder and president of ETC (Ethnic Television Channel), the first and only English-language television cable channel; candidate for Clerk of the City of Chicago; active member of various Democratic Party organizations; led tours

to Poland, Germany, and Russia, since he was fluent in those languages; producer of several documentaries on Polish topics; television, print and on-line journalist; social and political commentator.

T. Ron dedicated himself to anything he became involved with, often readily taking a leadership role, captivating everyone with his infectious laugh. He was a friend and mentor to many generations, a strong defender of all things Polish, and great friend of Polonia. T. Ron served on the IPA Board of directors for several years. He also took pictures for the organization and also was the webmaster of the organization for several years.

Leon Kozicki Trustee's Award Presentation

Over the years, the IPA Polka Hall of Fame® and Music Awards processes have rightfully recognized deserving polka musicians who attained prominence in the polka industry for their musical achievements that helped promote polka music and broaden its audience. Because of their highly visible roles, bandleaders, or "front men and women," usually received most of the recognition for their groups' success that may have contributed to their winning individual awards or their eventual inductions into the Polka Hall of Fame. Unfortunately, exceptionally talented band mates who also contributed greatly to the success of their groups, often never received their due recognition.

To address this situation, the IPA Polka Hall of Fame and Music Awards Committee collaborated with the body of Trustees to establish a new annual award to recognize these deserving "side L-R: Leon Kozicki Trustee Award Winner Tom Kula, IPA men or women" of notable polka bands. To honor the legacy of Co-Founder Leon Kozicki, IPA Trustee Tish Blazonczyk, the long-time Chairman of the IPA Polka Hall of Fame, Leon and IPA Advisor Jerry Wantroba. Kozicki, the committee and Trustees also recommended the



award be titled "The Leon Kozicki Trustees Award." The IPA Board of Directors approved the establishment of the award effective this year.

Candidates for The Leon Kozicki Award must meet the following criteria: 1.) must not have been inducted into the IPA Polka Hall of Fame nor be listed on the current year's ballot (note: receiving this award would not disqualify deserving candidates from subsequent Polka Hall of Fame consideration); 2.) Must have at least 15 years of dedicated, significant service to the same prominent musical group and/or leader; and 3.) May not be deceased. Each year during the Hall of Fame/Awards cycle, the IPA Polka Hall of Fame Committee develops a short list of potential award candidates. The list is shared with the Trustees who vote to determine their choice of the most deserving candidate. The winner is contacted by the PHOF Committee and invited to attend the annual IPA Polka Hall of Fame and Music Awards Banquet to receive the award. If necessary, the award is presented at another time and location to accommodate the needs and preferences of the recipient. A plaque similar to The Joe Jozwiak Award is presented to the winner with a replica submitted for display in the IPA Polka Hall of Fame Museum. The award winner or representative receives a complimentary ticket to the banquet if he or she is able to attend.

The inaugural recipient of The Leon Kozicki Trustees Award is Tom Kula. Tom performed with the original Ampol Aires for over 50 years and continued appearing with the New Ampol Aires for an additional 13 years. His extraordinary musical talents and contributions to this legendary musical group epitomize the intent of this award. IPA Advisor Jerry Wantroba presented Tom Kula with his award on October 11, 2015 during a performance by the Ampol Aires at a Let's Polka USA Dance at Glendora Banquets. The International Polka Association extends hardy congratulations and heartfelt appreciation to Tom Kula for his remarkable polka career.

Those who desire to nominate themselves or other candidates for IPA Polka Hall of Fame induction consideration must provide a biography of the nominee, not to exceed two single-spaced pages. This biography must also accompany a completed IPA Polka Hall of Fame Nomination Form. The form can be found at ipapolka.com under the "Hall of Fame / Awards" tab. The form is also available by request by writing to: IPA Polka Music Hall of Fame Nomination, P.O. Box 91, Dover, DE 19903. The biography and nomination form must be mailed together to the address above so that the submission is postmarked by December 31st.






