
# New Release Boys' Stories



**Current:** This allocation of elected officers shall be maintained until August, 2015 when it may be revised at the annual meeting.

**Change to:** This allocation of elected officers shall be maintained until it may be revised at the annual meeting.

# <u>Under Article VIII – Meetings</u>

**Current:** The annual meeting of this association shall be held each August, and should coincide with the annual festival at a time and location to be determined by the executive board.

**Change to:** The annual meeting of this association shall be held at the Annual Festival & Convention at a time and location to be determined by the executive board.

# Article X, Section 1 - Election of Officers

**Current:** The election of officers of the International Polka Association shall be by secret ballot at the annual convention meeting in August of each year according to established tradition and custom.

**Change to:** The election of officers of the International Polka Association shall be by secret ballot at the annual convention of each year according to established tradition and custom.

# Article X, Section 3 - Election of Officers


**Current:** The officers who have been elected shall assume office on September 1 of the year elected

**Change to:** The officers who have been elected shall assume office as soon as they take their oath office.

It was an amazing weekend with 15 polka bands playing in three halls and for downtown street dances. We kicked off the fun with a Polka On! Pre-Party with music by Czech & Then Some. Louis Stewart of Moulton, Texas, and Elaine Rosquist of Loveland, Colorado, won the dance contest and were crowned festival King & Queen.

SqueezeBox with Ted Lange (new IPA Hall of Famer) and Mollie B (2018 IPA Hall of Famer) was a crowd favorite. A special presentation was made to Mollie B by TSgt Nick Kenneally. He presented Mollie a flag that was flown in her honor on an Air Force mission in Southwest Asia last September by the 779th Expeditionary Airlift Squadron as they supported America's war on terrorism. She also received a certificate from the Air Force signed by the six men of the Chrome 65 crew. TSgt Kenneally first became aware of Mollie B through his parents who attend Jim Busta Band's polka Mass in Farley, Iowa. They also enjoy the "Mollie B Polka Party" TV show. Additionally, TSgt Kenneally shared that his squadron have come to enjoy YouTube videos of Mollie B and SqueezeBox.

### **More Hot Times**

It's church picnic season in Texas with lots of great food, social activities, and of course, POLKA! I thought I would mention a few of the picnics that have passed the century mark in celebrations.

- Sts. Peter & Paul Parish, Plum, Texas (near La Grange), June 30. 122<sup>nd</sup> annual celebration. Features a Polka Mass, dinner with the famous Plum sausage and fried chicken, and music by The Czechaholics.
- St. John the Baptist Picnic, St. John, Texas (near Schulenburg), July 4<sup>th</sup>. 131 years. Features Mass in one of the area's designated Painted Churches, fried chicken dinner with the famous St. John stew, fireworks, and music by the Shiner Hobo Band, Red Ravens, Dujka Brothers, Texas Dream.
- Sts. Cyril & Methodius Feast, Dubina Texas (near La Grange). 163<sup>rd</sup> year. Features a Polka Mass in the Painted Church with "Dubina-Style" fried chicken and sausage dinner, classic car show, and music by Mark Halata & Texavia and Lost Cause. To keep the party going from the St. John Picnic to the Dubina Picnic, Texas Polka News is sponsoring Stars, Stripes & Polka On! dance at the KC Hall in Schulenburg on Saturday, July 6. TPN subscribers get in half price and receive a free drink ticket. The Czechaholics will provide the great music.
- The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Praha, Texas (near Schulenburg). 164<sup>th</sup> year. Another one of the area's painted churches recently restored and given a Texas historical marker. Always held on the feast day of the assumption Aug. 15. Features famous Praha stew and fried chicken dinner and music by The Praha Brothers, Dujka Brothers, and All Around Czechs.
