



Newsletter Article Contribution Process



IPA HALL OF FAME BENEFIT DANCE

Another great crowd was in attendance for the 15th Annual IPA Hall of Fame Benefit Dance at the PACC in Ludlow, Mass this past March. The kickoff on Saturday, March 7th featured the music of John Gora and Gorale. A fantastic show was put on by John and the polka fans enjoyed every minute of his performance.

Sunday, March 8th saw another dynamic crowd meeting with friends from over six states in attendance. Dennis Polisky and The Maestro's Men, Eddie Forman and EFO, and Lenny Gomulka and Chicago Push rocked the house with great polka music.

The highlight of the evening was a tribute to this year's honoree, Ed Guca. During the 70's and 80's Ed Guca and the Polish Canadians were one of the most celebrated bands playing throughout the US and Canada. Ed is still performing today and a tribute to his music and contribution to Polka music was done by an All-Star Band and Ed got up on the stage and wowed the crowd for a Grand Finale.



2020 Leon Koyicki Award Winner Robbie Piatkowski

ver the years, the IPA Polka Hall of Fame® and Music Awards processes have rightfully recognized deserving polka musicians who attained prominence in the polka industry for their musical achievements that helped promote polka music and broaden its audience. Because of their highly visible roles, bandleaders, or "front men and women," usually received most of the recognition for their groups' suc-



cess that may have contributed to their winning individual awards or their eventual inductions into the Polka Hall of Fame. Unfortunately, exceptionally talented band mates who also contributed greatly to the success of their groups, often never received their due recognition.

To address this situation, the IPA Polka Hall of Fame and Music Awards Committee collaborated with the body of Trustees to establish a new annual award to recognize these deserving "side men or women" of notable polka bands. To honor the legacy of the long-time Chairman of the IPA Polka Hall of Fame, Leon Kozicki, the committee and Trustees also recommended the award be titled "The Leon Kozicki Trustees Award." The IPA Board of Directors approved the establishment of the award effective in 2015.

Candidates for The Leon Kozicki Award must meet the following criteria:

- 1.) must not have been inducted into the IPA Polka Hall of Fame nor be listed on the current year's ballot (note: receiving this award would not disqualify deserving candidates from subsequent Polka Hall of Fame consideration)
- 2.) Must have at least 15 years of dedicated, significant service to the same prominent musical group and/or leader
- May not be deceased. Each year during the Hall of Fame/Awards cycle, the IPA Polka Hall of Fame Committee develops a short list of potential award candidates.

The list is shared with the Trustees who vote to determine their choice of the most deserving candidate. The winner is contacted by the PHOF Committee and invited to attend the annual IPA Polka Hall of Fame and Music Awards Banquet to receive the award. If necessary, the award is presented at another time and location to accommodate the needs and preferences of the recipient. A plaque similar to The Joe Jozwiak Award is presented to the winner with a replica submitted for display in the IPA Polka Hall of Fame Museum.



Polka community comes together to show its love for Chester Kowalski

The polka community did what it does best and rallied around one of its own on Saturday, April 25, 2020. Chester Kowalski, who turned 85 years old in February, is one of the most visible members of Western New York's Polish and polka communities.

For the past couple of years, he has been battling cancer and despite his illness he has still attended nearly all the polka events. But his battle with cancer has become more difficult in the past

In response, the polka community did what it does best and came together for one of its most popular members in Polonia.

Hundreds of Chester's family and friends from the polka community showed their love and support for him and organized a parade of cars that drove past his Depew home on April 25. According to the Town, there were 200-plus cars that drove from the Apple Tree Mall parking lot, down Como Park, to Chester's house.

It all started when Melissa Jozwiak had an idea on April 19.

A week earlier, on Easter Sunday, Melissa spoke with her husband, Shane and wanted to call Chester, who Melissa refers to as Chet. For the past several years the Jozwiak's would spend time with Chester and his longtime friend, Elinor Mach Pittner Baczkiewicz for Pre-Dyngus Day and Dyngus Day celebrations. "Easter Sunday, I told Shane that we should call Chet and I called him, and he could barely talk, and I was so sad," said Melissa Jozwiak.

"On Tuesday I thought, I wish I would have thought about having a parade for Chet. It wouldn't have mattered anyway, the weather was terrible," said Jozwiak.

"Then we were watching an old Sportsman's video of Chet dancing and I looked at Shane and I go, 'Why don't we do a polka parade for Chet?' Because we did a parade for Shane's dad the week before because he had his 75th birthday," Melissa said. "So, I asked Shane and he said do whatever you think, and I said, 'I am going to call Ronnie since we are friends with Ronnie and ask him for his opinion.

"So, I called up Ronnie and I said, 'You have the connections, I have a couple people I can call, do you want to take this over or should I plan it?' Ronnie goes, 'It's a great idea, you plan it. So, then I called Charlene Krasuski and Jen Pijanowski and that is where it blew up and we ended up having over 200 cars." Melissa enlisted the help of people in the polka community who she knew could spread the word like Charlene and Jen and Steve Brown. Melissa told them to get the word out about the parade for Chester and it spread like wildfire.

"I called Elinor Sunday, because I had a feeling this was going to be big and then I called her again Friday and then she told him because she didn't want him to be overwhelmed with the amount of people. It was a good thing she told him. He was very happy," said Melissa.

A special surprise that Chester was unaware of until Saturday was that there was going to be live polka music playing in his driveway. Polka musicians from multiple Western New York polka bands came together to play for over an hour and provide Chester with his favorite music, polka music.

Jimmy Nowaczewski, Ricky Krew, and Paul Dominiak from Phocus, Tommy Goldyn and Ted Szymanski from Special Delivery, and Ken Machelski and Tadj Szymczak from The Buffalo Touch, and Eric Bakowski were the musicians that set up in the driveway in front of the house to entertain Chester and those who came to show their support.

"All in all, I thought it was a very thoughtful thing to do for him. He appreciated it very much," said Jimmy Nowaczewski. "It was an honor and a pleasure to have a friend like that in my life and I would do anything that he would ask me to. To me it was an honor to have him in my life."

Chester's family including his children and grandchildren were there to celebrate Chester and show how much they love him.

Chester's niece, Linda Ziolkowski-Lund, owner of Babcia's Pierogi, was not surprised by all the outpouring of love that the Polish community showed to her uncle on Saturday.

"It didn't surprise me, but it was very overwhelming. It was hard to not get choked up watching his reaction. Uncle Chester is a living legend. I don't think people will understand how important he is to the Polish community until he's no longer with us," said Ziolkowski-Lund.

"Uncle Chester is the strongest man I've ever known, physically and mentally, but he's always had a heart of gold. He's always been the life of the party and the man who can always make you laugh. It's very fitting that was honored with a parade to celebrate the man he is and to show how much he is truly loved."

Czeslaw "Chester" Kowalski entered into Eternal Life on Monday, May 11th at the age of 85. He was the beloved husband of the late Judith (nee Ziolkowski) Kowalski; dearest father of Sandra (Bob) Andrews, William Kowalski and Scott (Julie) Kowalski; dear grandfather of Lauren, Brooke, Mason, Zane and Broc; great grandfather of Eli; son of the late Bronislaw and Janina (nee Kapala) Kowalski; brother of late Edward Kowalski, Irek (Rosie) Kowalski and Bernice (Henry) Barnas; brother-in-law of David (Carol) Ziolkowski and the late Donald Ziolkowski; also survived by nieces and nephews. 
